Funded by CAE Healthcare, the Hayden Vanguard Lectureship honors the work of Jennifer Hayden, who completed one of the largest and most meaningful nursing education studies ever devised – the National Council of State Boards of Nursing: National Simulation Study.

The lectureship will be awarded annually to an INACSL member who has contributed to the discipline and moved simulation forward in a meaningful way through research, program, evaluation, or similar scholarly product. Starting in 2016 the recipient will present a one-hour plenary address about his/her innovation or research during the endnote session at the INACSL Conference held each June.
